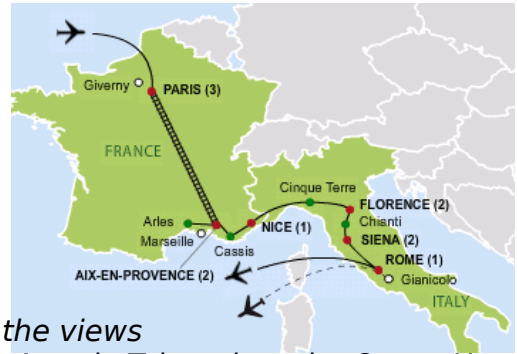


The Best of France & Italy

Day 1 - Paris...Fly overnight to France.



Days 2-4 - Paris...See the sights of Paris. Whether you choose to stroll the Champs Elysees, marvel at the views of Notre Dame, Sacre Coeur, Montmartre, the Arc de Triomphe, the Opera House, or cross the bridges of Paris while gazing at the Eiffel Tower or view the Pyramid posed before the Louvre, or pass the Rodin Gardens and Les Invalides, your trip will be exciting. At night opt for a cruise on the Seine River or take in other sights of the city at your leisure.

Day 5 - Aix-en-Provence...Travel by high-speed TGV train to the French Riviera. Enjoy a guided tour of the medieval town of Aix-en-Provence located on the Mediterranean.

Day 6 - Aix-en-Provence...Tour one of the top tourist destinations in the Provence area, the medieval town of Arles. The tour is followed by a Provençal Lunch. Take time in the afternoon to explore this medieval area..

Day 7 - Nice...Your journey through the French Riviera continues with a stop in the seaside gem of Cassis located on the Mediterranean. Board a boat for a leisurely cruise. Arrive by evening in Nice.



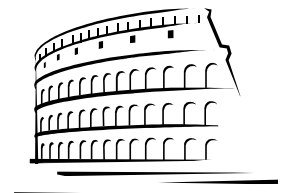
Day 8 - Florence...Cross into Italy and stop in the scenic region of Cinque Terre (Five Towns) before continuing on to Tuscany. Cinque Terre is dramatically situated in the heart of the Italian Riviera on the Mediterranean.

Day 9 - Florence...A professional guide leads a tour of Florence, featuring views of the Gates of Paradise, Chiesa di Santa Croce and the magnificent Duomo. Cross the Ponte Vecchio for magnificent views of the city.

Day 10 - Siena...Today, take a guided tour of the Pitti Palace, a treasure-trove of Renaissance art. Later, journey into Chianti, home of the famous Gallo Nero wine route, for an exclusive tasting at a Tuscan vineyard. Arrive later in Siena, one of Tuscany's most stunning medieval towns.

Day 11 - Siena...On today's walking tour, see the famous Piazza del Campo and the marble Duomo, dedicated to Siena's patron saint, Catherine. You'll learn about Siena's rivalry with Florence and view works by Donatello.

Day 12 - Rome...Upon your arrival in Rome this afternoon, begin your exploration of this marvelous city. Whether you gaze at the Colosseum and the Forum or step into the Pantheon, walk the Spanish Steps or throw a coin into Trevi Fountain your day will be filled with Italian excitement. Take time to step into St. Peter's Square and marvel at the St. Peter's Basilica.



Day 13 - Rome...Add 2 nights in Rome. (\$299 dbl) to spend more time enjoying the sights.

This trip mixes the lights and hustle of big cities with the leisure and atmosphere of smaller towns. Choose to participate in guided visits, sign-up for optional excursions, travel the city at your leisure, be led by me, or combine all of these to make memories that will last a lifetime.
